1- I request that the airman performance report
 AF Form 909 period of report and supervision from
 24 May 76 three 7 Feb 78 be voided.

2- I received a copy of AF Form 909 dated 8 Feb 78 in
 February 78 from CPO, Hancock Field, N.Y. and
 19// I received a copy dated 7 Feb 78 from Sgt
 Butcher, the reporting official, on 31 Mar 78.

3- On 31 Mar 78 at 1100 to 1120 hours, Sgt Butcher told me:
 that he "was coerced by Dumas to lower the
 APP" (Dumas is the ^{SMS} 1st Sgt), "he had seven stripes
 and what he said sounded right"; "he was kinda forced",
 the "Commander said he directed Dumas to change
 APP" (Lt Col Edwards is the Commander), "he didn't go along with ^{the said} _{it}"
 On 31 Mar 78 at 1245 to 1315 hours, Sgt Butcher also said:
 "The coerced me to lower APP and he isn't in chain of
 command".

On the 7 Feb 78 AF Form 909 section regarding Recommended
 Improvement Areas, Sgt Butcher said "Dumas wrote it",

activities", "from a 7 to a 4". Butcher said "Dumas did the mass in item #2 blocks".
the entire paragraph, and then Colleen tore it up
but I saved it". He then recognized ^{SMSgt} Dumas' words in his
own handwriting on bottom part of the APP.

SMSgt Dumas asked Sgt Butcher, "does he participate
in shop activities?" Butcher said "no", SMSgt Dumas then
changed the part number III Personal Qualities item #2
working relations from a "number 7 to a number 4".

Butcher said "Dumas did" the changing of the blocks.

Butcher also said that "Dumas crossed out"
several lines in the section of Facts + Specific
Achievements, and in the endorsing officials'
comments Dumas crossed out the word
minimum & he wrote "the word strongest".

On 31 Mar 78 from 1245 to 1315 hours, I had written
a summary paper based upon Butchers' conversation
with me earlier, he read it. I asked him if he
agreed with its contents, he agreed by nodding
his head forward & saying "yes" but he wouldn't
sign the paper, he was afraid to get into trouble!

On 18 Nov 77, SSgt Wright, Social Actions NCO informed me that Sgt Butcher had told him ^{on 17 Nov 77 at 0800 hrs.} that he would rate Alc Pugan "overall 9" ^{the two} APR. Eighty three days later I received an overall 6 evaluation.

On 17 Jan 78 approximately 0740 hours, I received a "Letter of Consolation" dated 16 Jan 78, without any prior notification verbal or written [↓] stating "~~Alcman~~ ~~Pugan~~" actions does not rate a Satisfactory APR at the present time. Attachment 4. This letter of consolation contradicts his 17 Nov 77 statement.

On 22 Feb 78, I submitted to Sgt Butcher, my letter of rebuttal; ^(Attachment 5) He would not discuss either letters with me, he avoided the subject. Because of the inconsistencies that were stated in the 16 Jan 78 "Letter of Consolation", I asked ^{Mr. Lee WS-11} my ^{to my understanding} official, next in the chain of command to help me clarify them; he said "can't help you" and "I can't make him withdraw it". My next civil engineering forman Mr. Charles Lewis WS-12 also said "I can't help, maybe someone else".

On 17 May 78 at 0830 hours, I asked Mr. Lee WS-11 to assist me with a statement of his knowledge regarding the misunderstanding & possible coercion surrounding ^{the two} APR. He said "don't

I know anything about this, have to ask Dumas".
I reminded him that he endorsed both APR's, he
said "no, can't commit myself either way".
I never received a reply written or verbal + I
did not ask him again.

Inconsistencies in APR *attach 4*

1 - On AF Form 909 dated 7 Feb 78 in the Comments/
Endorsements VII section under the heading of
Strengths, "she is able to work harmoniously
with others and responds well to specific
instructions" is contrary to the AF Form 909
dated 8 Feb 78 in the Comments/Endorsements VII
section under the heading of Recommended
Improvement Areas, "she tends to stay outside
of section activities and does not relate harmoniously
with her superiors or her peers"

On 31 Mar 78 at 1245 to 1315 Hours, Sgt Butcher
told me that SMSGT Dumas * crossed out "the
bias ^{Name misspelled}"

2 - On AF Form 909 dated 8 Feb 78 in the
Comments/Endorsements VII section under the
heading of Recommended Improvement Areas,
"Alc. Rng requires periodic counseling to insure
she completes some assigned tasks" ^{& Before 17 Jan 78}
which was presented with "letter of consolation" ^{attach 4}
I had never been ^{notified} informed either verbally or in

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that my written form by anyone " & lack of cooperation & latity of duties "... does not rate a Satisfactory APR".
The reporting official, repeatedly stated to me that my duty performance was a "9 APR".
I have not received periodic counseling from the reporting official.

3- Attn neither of the AF Form 909 dates 7 Feb 78 or 8 Feb 78 (attach 28) were my continuing educational efforts mentioned. I ^{voluntarily} enrolled in the seven level skill extension course ^{Dec 77} institute for my career field. I have completed the majority of the credits required for the 542X0 career field. I am the only Airman in the ~~the~~ organization attempting to obtain an Associates Degree in Community College of the Air Force for my career field.

4- The undersigned official, Mr Arthur P. Lee WS-11 ~~concurred~~ in both AF Form 909 dates 7 Feb 78 & 8 Feb 78 (attach 28) ^{stated} "I fully concur with Sgt Butcher's rating"; on 23 Feb 78 I asked him to explain the delay in the initial due date for APR. He said "didn't know it was so overdue however ~~on 23 Feb 78 when~~" I asked him to explain the reason for the delay of my initial APR due date Nov 77 until Feb 78. He said "didn't know it was so overdue, it is confidential and can't tell you anything", I should have looked into this long time ago".

I was ^{not} notified that my reporting official had changed in Oct 77 until Feb 78.
